## RULES

1. Proof of One Million Dollar Liability must be available on day of show.
2. Judges ruling will be final.
3. If there is a protest about the height of any miniature horse entered at the show, the show official measurement will be final.
4. All exhibitors and handlers in the ring must be properly attired in all classes.
5. All horses entered in youth classes must have a header.
6. In order to constitute an entry each competitor must sign an entry form and 12 years old and over pay \$8.00 exhibitor fee. If under 12 years old and exhibit in an open class, they need to pay the \$8.00 exhibitor fee. Entries taken until 1 hour before the show at 8:00 a.m.
